re; Appointment of a TREASURER.

Further to my Newsletter to you in August, the arrangements for this URGENT Meeting have now been finalised. The meeting will begin at 7pm on Tuesday, September 6th, in the Green Room in the FRONT HALL.

During "Lockdown", our Treasurer, Nigel Taylor, had to sort out an unexpected financial situation for us. After resolving it, Nigel had come to the end of his term as Hon. Treasurer. We owe him our thanks.

The Society now needs a new Treasurer.

Without a Treasurer, the South Wales Art Society cannot function. We cannot pay for anything. As a direct result of this, I am still waiting for the £160 which I personally paid (20 Tickets @ £8 each), for entry to the IWM Exhibition last May. I cannot pay this money to myself.

Without a Treasurer, I am willing to foot the bill for Hall rental until a new Treasurer is appointed. However, I am not prepared to pay for all of the Demonstrators Claire Sadlier has lined up for SWAS this coming session. I do not think that our Members would want to "pay at the door" each time they come to watch a Demonstration either. e.g. If we pay £200.00 to each Demonstrator and only 20 Members turn up, the entry fee to each member would be £10 per meeting. With 2 Demos. per month until Christmas break, we are talking about potentially £80 for each Member to cover the costs! Annual Membership only costs £35......if we have a TREASURER.

Please try and attend the meeting. We need to resolve this problem so that our venerable Society can continue.
